CEAS Culture Survey Results – Summary

Utilizing the Campus Culture Survey (CCS) [Unit-level dashboard](#) and the [CCS Executive Summary](#), we are exploring how CEAS compares to the areas of strength and concern that were highlighted for campus. Overall, CEAS results are very similar to campus findings for areas of concern and positive findings. Among our graduate student participants, we seem to be doing better on a number of items compared to campus. In this summary, differences are called out between CEAS and campus when it was > 5 percentage points.
